

PRIVILEGES FOR UAB RETIREES (Updated 2.2017)

To take advantage of these privileges, please present your retiree identification card identifying you as a retired UAB employee. If you have questions concerning your privileges, please contact the Office of Human Resource Management Benefits at 205-934-3458.

As a UAB Retiree you are now eligible for the many privileges listed below:

1. You may check out books at the Mervyn H. Sterne Library and the Lister Hill Library.
2. You may purchase season tickets for UAB Athletics at a 20% discounted rate. To obtain more information, please contact the UAB ticket office at 975-8216.
3. You receive a 10% discount from the Barnes and Nobles Bookstore, in the Hill Student Center, on UAB products and general readings.
4. You may obtain a "Guest Parking Permit" for parking. The permit will be valid for one day, and the retiree will be allowed to park in all lots labeled LOT 15. You will stop by Parking & Transportation office at 608 8th Street South; Monday - Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
5. You may receive discounts to any event on campus when tickets are discounted to faculty and staff.
6. The Educational Assistance benefit is also available to all unmarried dependent children under age 26 of UAB retired employees who were in an eligible status at the time of retirement and for at least one year immediately prior to retirement. The one year of service requirement is waived for full-time regular faculty members. Qualified dependent children will receive 50% tuition assistance for all undergraduate credit courses taken during an academic term only at UAB and only where UAB Academic Credit is received. Audited courses and other fees are not included.
7. You are eligible to receive membership to the UAB Recreation Center at a discounted rate. With a 12-month contract you can pay a fee of \$360 or a monthly fee of \$30. With a 3-month contract you can pay a fee of \$120 or a monthly fee of \$40. You can contact UAB Recreation Center at 934-8224.
8. You are eligible to become a member in the UAB Retiree Association. UABRA is an independent, self-governing organization of active members whose primary purpose is to serve and promote the interests and welfare of retirees from the UAB faculty and staff, including UAB Hospital.
